To remove the Japanese Knotweed and prevent it spreading across an industrial estate in Govan, Glasgow, LK Pollution Response are using a blend of herbicides over a four year period.

After discussion with the site's owners the method of herbicide treatment was the chosen option of Japanese Knotweed remediation. It was considered the best method as the contamination was identified early and was still relatively small. The benefits of identifying the Japanese Knotweed early and seeking advice immediately were that a more intrusive, and expensive, treatment option involving a controlled excavation was avoided.

LK Pollution Response have also consulted with National Rail and Strathclyde Passenger Transport, the neighbouring land owners, on how to prevent re contamination of the Glasgow site.
