The Metrolink operators contacted LK Pollution Response to control the rising amount of Japanese Knotweed present along the Manchester to Bury line. Japanese Knotweed was migrating from the embankments to properties adjoining the line and causing significant damage.

LK Pollution Response mobilised within 24 hours to commence spraying of the areas that were causing most damage to stop any immediate re-growth. From this initial spray LK Pollution Response carried out a survey of the area and issued the client with a management plan consisting of a spraying and monitoring programme split into various categories.



The Japanese Knotweed spraying and monitoring programme is ongoing into its third year with little regrowth observed and no further migration of Japanese Knotweed to adjoining properties
