The Queens Road Development for Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council is a large urban regeneration area. Japanese Knotweed was identified in many locations throughout the area and halted demolition, until LKA used a combination of controlled excavation and spraying regimes to allow construction work to continue.

LK Pollution Response are aiding Manchester City Council in reclaiming residents back gardens from Japanese Knotweed and releasing the footpaths and access routes in the local vicinity by applying spraying combined programme and excavation techniques..
