In 2006 LKPR were asked to provide a quote for the removal of Japanese Knotweed that was growing along the fence line and by the house of certain properties in Croydon, London that was preventing an extension being built to the property.

LKPR visited the site and devised an appropriate management plan that was acceptable to the client in terms of scale and price. Once the method statement was agreed work commenced and was completed in a three day period. The method agreed on was a dig, sift and bury method, with the excavated material being buried on site in a corner of the garden. LKPR also implemented a monitoring programme to ensure that any re-growth is dealt with accordingly.
